1. Present: George Seiler, Dawn Oakley, Le Ann Wasmoen, Cassidy Metzinger, and Chessa Quenzer.
2. Director Report
 - CADCA (Community Anti-Drug Coalitions of America)-February 2-7
 - Le Ann gave a review of the CADCA Leadership Forum in National Harbor, MD and time in DC. Meet with Senator Thune, Senator Rounds, and Rep. Dusty Johnson. Met with SADD CEO Rick Birt. Went to a lot of workshops. Great opportunity to learn new information, data, and make networking. Network feedback with other coalitions was very positive. Met with potential vendors to partner with. Heard from national directors on current and emerging national issues. 13 SD people there: coalitions, Prevention Resource Center personnel, and State Prevention leadership
 - Additional State Funding update: Haven't heard back yet, but hopefully we will hear back in the next few weeks. We've expended some of our categories in community development, etc... Looking for additional funding in those areas.

 - Pride Surveys: Got the pride survey back before we left. Sent it off to Roland for evaluations. We have some questions about data analysis yet. We will give the school the analysis when it's complete.

5. Recovery Support Team/Narcotics Anonymous-
 - Recovery House-501c3: Paul Gillette will work on the non profit status.
 - Stigma Training-June: Law enforcement, hospital, clinic, EMS on addiction and stigma. Dr. Melanie Weiss will be the keynote speaker. Met with county commissioners and city council to hopefully make the training mandatory. Possible grant available.
6. Spink Area Support Network (SASN)-
 - Assist Training-January 15 & 16: Great training. About 40 people there. Hoping we can bring the training to the SASN team.

7. Community/School Tobacco Prevention Partnership Grant: Open March 4th, due April 24th. Great grant for both community and school programming. Will apply for CORE day funding dollars in the grant that we didn't get last year.
8. Highway Traffic Safety grant: Meeting in March. Will purchase simulator equipment soon. Informed county commissioners at their meeting. Supported by Spink Co. Sheriff Frank Krumm. Will start planning National Night Out in April.
